This month marks the 13th anniversary of Matthew Shepard's death.

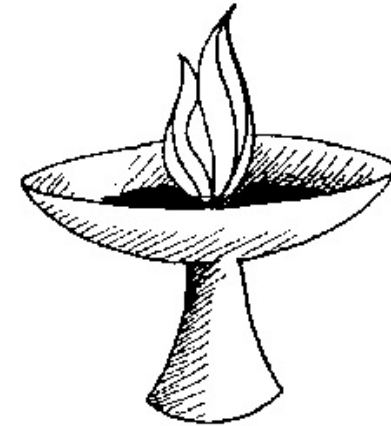
